PARADE OF SAIL INSTRUCTIONS

There will be a Parade of Sail of vessels participating in the 2011 Gloucester Schooner Festival on Sunday, September 4, at 10:30 a.m. All participating vessels are welcome to join the parade.

The Parade will proceed from Gloucester's Inner Harbor, past the Fishermen's Monument (Man at the Wheel Statue on Stacy Boulevard), and then leading out of the Outer Harbor to the Starting Area for the Mayor's Race off Eastern Point Light along the route shown on the "Route Diagram" on the reverse side of these instructions.

- ◆ Time of Parade: 10.30 a.m. – 12:00 noon.
- ◆ The parade will be informal in that there will be no specific order of vessels. However, the schooner *Thomas E. Lannon* will lead the parade and set the course for all vessels to follow.
- ◆ Each vessel should proceed along the parade route so that she approaches the Fishermen's Monument closely enough for the narrator to give her proper recognition as she sails by the monument. Cannon salutes are welcome.
- ◆ Gloucester Harbormaster, Harbor Police, and U.S. Coast Guard boats will patrol the route to minimize possible spectator craft interference with the Parade.
